REFLECTION from Fr. Lincoln: Jesus tells us today that we are to fear no one. In the midst of turmoil, violence, and destruction, the Church faces those fears and does not back down. In our lives of faith, we are not to be the disciples who have the flashiest ministries and who aim toward getting the most accolades and the greatest attention. We are to quietly and humbly proclaim the Gospel of the Lord. So many in our society want to attack others and tear them down.
