<u>PASTORS REFLECTION</u>: When Pope Francis chose the date of a Sunday liturgy to commemorate grandparents and the elders of our community, he chose the date closest to the feast day of St Anne and St Joachim, the parents of the blessed Virgin Mary, which is celebrated on July 26 each year.
