**REFLECTION from Fr. Lincoln:** We here in the Diocese of Jackson have a very diverse Catholic community. We have different ministries reaching out to the children and youth, to college students, and to the inmates at the prisons in our state. St Paul had a vision of reaching out to all, no matter what their race or status in life or religious background. We hear from the first letter he wrote to the Christian community in Thessalonica in Greece, a community he founded, a community that faced a lot of challenges on its journey of faith. St Paul reminds them that they are a community that is bathed by the light of Christ, that they are not a community rooted in the darkness of the world. During our own

challenges and difficulties, let us feel the light of Christ accompanying us on our journey. Let us bring that light of Christ to others. Have a blessed week everyone.
