REFLECTION from Fr. Lincoln: Just as Jesus called Andrew and Simon to discipleship during the reality of daily life, Jesus calls each one of us to discipleship in the context of our own lived reality. While we initially assume discipleship in the waters of baptism, during our journey of faith, we are called to conversion, repentance, and renewal. Most important, our discipleship is not something we treasure for ourselves, but out of our discipleship, we are called to serve others. Thus, it is important that we stay active in our life of
