Fr. Lincoln's Reflection

On April 30, 2000, at the canonization of Sister Faustina Kowalska, Pope John Paul II declared that the second Sunday of the Easter season would be known as Divine Mercy Sunday. This reflects the devotion that so many Catholic faithful have to Christ's divine mercy. However, God's divine mercy dates back before the revelations of Sister Faustina in 1931. The Catechism states that "the Gospel is the revelation in Jesus Christ of God's mercy to sinners." Pope Benedict XVI reinforced this by stating that "Divine Mercy is not a secondary devotion, but an integral dimension of Christian faith and prayer." God's mercy meets us in the midst of our suffering and our brokenness. In his divine mercy, God's love meets us and helps us in this reality. God's mercy is that for all of us, no matter what darkness we have in our lives. May the message of Divine Mercy Sunday be an integral part of our faith. 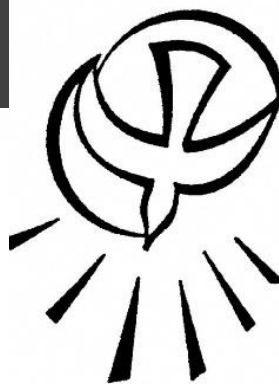
Adult RE will resume on April 7 at 9 a.m. in McGing Hall with “A Biblical Walk through the Mass”
