With Christ being seen as God's light in the world, his presentation in the Temple was also traditionally known as Candlemass, with a blessing of candles being a part of the celebration ritual of the day. I love all the rituals and traditions that we have in our Catholic faith. It will be about a month from now when we enter the holy season of Lent with Ash Wednesday on March 5.
