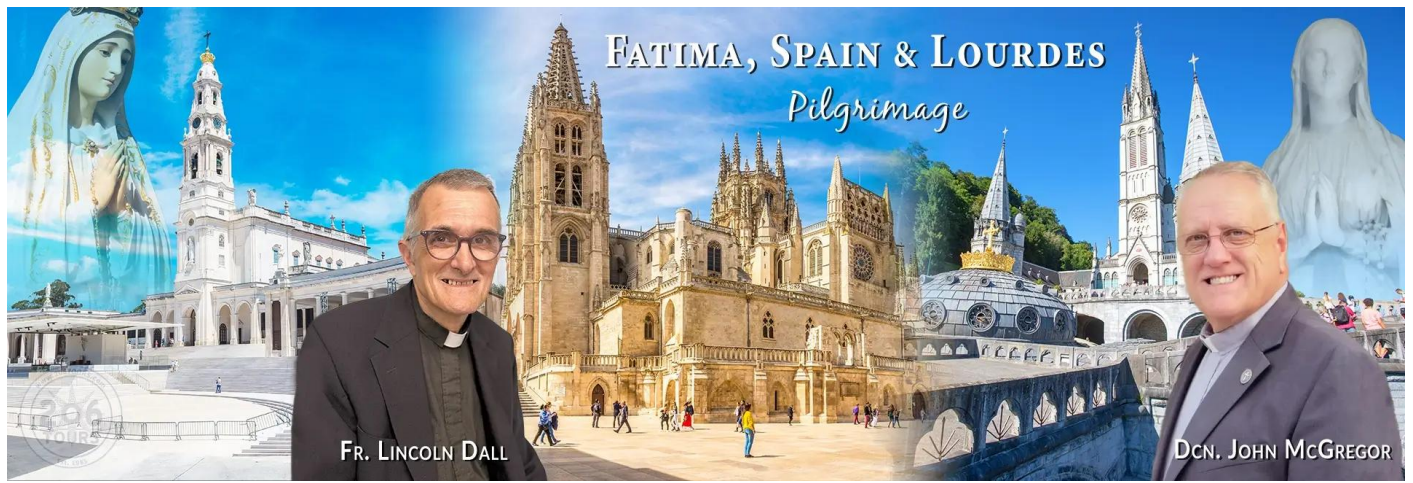

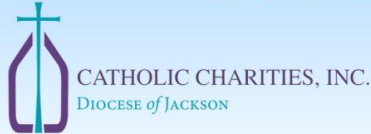
You are invited to join the Diocese of Jackson on a 10-day journey to Italy as pilgrims of hope during the 2025 Jubilee!

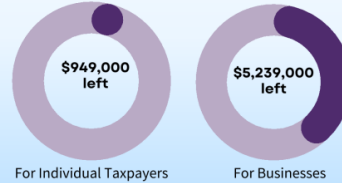

The 2025 Children's Promise Act is live!

A limited amount of credit is available to be claimed.
Here's what it looks like now:



Here's how to claim:



Step 1: Complete the MS Department of Revenue application. Available now.



Step 2: Make a donation to Catholic Charities to provide help and create hope for all God's children.



Step 3: Send the verification of the donation to the MSDOR.



Step 4: Receive a **DOLLAR-FOR-DOLLAR** tax credit!

Individuals can donate up to \$1,200 for credit (\$2,400 for married couples), and businesses can donate up to 50% of what they owe in taxes.

Catholic Charities, Inc. is a Qualified Charitable Organization (QCO) according to the Mississippi Department of Revenue (MSDOR). That is great news for our donors!
