Adult Education:

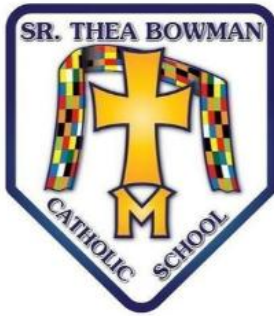



Step 1: Complete the MS Department of Revenue application. Available now.
