This weekend, we celebrate the end of the Easter season as we celebrate Pentecost, the coming of the Holy Spirit into the world. Red is the liturgical color of Pentecost, different from the white color of the rest of the Easter season. For the next three weekends, we will celebrate different feasts before we return to the Sundays of Ordinary Time: The Most Holy Trinity, The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (sometimes traditionally referred to as Corpus Christi), and the Saints Peter and Paul. I know that a lot of our parishioners and families travel during the summer months. I will be gone for some mission appeals as well to Rhode Island, California, and Iowa. As we celebrate Pentecost this weekend, we pray that we may all call upon the Holy Spirit to lead us and guide us on our journey of faith. Blessings to all of you. Father Lincoln.

Bishop Joseph Kopacz, together with the Office of Catholic Education and the Canonical Board of Pastors, has approved a comprehensive study of the four Catholic schools in the Jackson Metro area—St. Anthony, St. Joseph, St. Richard, and Sr. Thea Bowman Catholic Schools—and their associated early learning centers—Assisi ELC, St. Richard ELC and St. Paul ELC.

This study will explore ways to streamline operations, grow enrollment, and expand our Catholic presence in the metro area. A committee of parents and stakeholders will help guide the process. The study begins soon and will take 4–7 months. Please continue to pray for our schools and their mission of forming young minds and hearts in Christ in the Jackson Metro area.



Here's how to claim:




Step 1: Complete the MS Department of Revenue application. Available now.



Step 2: Make a donation to Catholic Charities to provide help and create hope for all God's children.



Step 3: Send the verification of the donation to the MSDOR



Step 4: Receive a **DOLLAR-FOR-DOLLAR** tax credit!

Individuals can donate up to \$1,200 for credit (\$2,400 for married couples), and businesses can donate up to 50% of what they owe in taxes.
