Catholic Quiz Answer: B

The Angelus is a cherished Catholic prayer that commemorates the Incarnation—when the Word became flesh in the person of Jesus Christ. Traditionally prayed three times a day (at 6 a.m., noon, and 6 p.m.), it invites the faithful to pause and reflect on the mystery of Christ's coming into the world through Mary.
